Fox Harb'r Resort founder, Ronald V. Joyce passed peacefully earlier this year, at his Burlington home surrounded by family. To witness his life was to witness the power and grace of a ship at full throttle. He was a pioneer and a mentor.

A father and a grandfather. A self-made man, selfless in his philanthropy. The wake he left will be felt for generations.

He was, of course, best-known as the legendary Canadian entrepreneur who in 1964 invested in the first Tim Hortons donut shop in Hamilton, and then grew the business into one of the world's most successful food service chains.

"My father had a big vision and a big heart. Through hard work, determination and drive, he built one of the most successful restaurant chains in Canada. But he never forgot his humble beginnings," noted Steven Joyce in a statement on behalf of the family.

A HISTORY OF GIVING BACK

A proud son of Tatamagouche, Mr. Joyce earned countless awards and honours for not only his entrepreneurial success, but also his steadfast commitment to corporate citizenship and philanthropy. Highlights of this recognition include The Order of Canada for his dedication to underprivileged children and youth; induction into the Canadian Business Hall of Fame; Entrepreneur of the Year for Ontario and Canada; the Gary Wright Humanitarian Award celebrating his outstanding contribution to better community life as founder of the Tim Hortons Children's Foundation with its famous camps; and the Red Cross Humanitarian of the Year Award.

His business achievements and contributions to future generations also earned him Philanthropist of the Year awards, and honourary doctoral degrees from several Canadian universities.

FROM DONUTS TO A DREAM DESTINATION

Mr. Joyce opened Fox Harb'r Resort in 2000, where many of our members made his acquaintance and became fast friends. Developing this retreat and supporting nearby cultural hubs like the Grace Jollymore Joyce Arts Centre, named after his mother, fulfilled his mission to provide much-needed employment opportunities on the Northumberland Shore. Mr. Joyce's passion for the resort, his Tatamagouche hometown and Nova Scotia was evident every time he stepped off his jet, when he often simply said, "So good to be back home."

In one of my earliest conversations with Mr. Joyce, he asked me to focus on three things while leading the Fox Harb'r team. "Quality. Quality and Quality."

All of us here miss Mr. Joyce deeply. Honouring his spirit and legacy, our team remains committed to being equally passionate stewards of this very special place and providing the "luxury without pretension," he so valued. Under Steven Joyce's leadership, Fox Harb'r will continue to grow and flourish, ensuring that our members continue to enjoy what Mr. Joyce knew as, "one of the most beautiful places on earth."


