The Vineyard Manager will develop and implement vineyard management practices that support the long-term health and productivity of the vines, including pruning, planting, fertilization, pest and disease management, irrigation, canopy management, harvesting, and general vineyard maintenance. The position is responsible for planning seasonal work, supervising vineyard team members and contractors, maintaining equipment and supplies, monitoring vineyard conditions, managing budgets, and ensuring all work is completed safely, efficiently, and to the standards expected at Fox Harb'r. The successful candidate will have a strong work ethic, excellent organizational and leadership skills, an understanding of horticulture or viticulture, and a passion for developing and maintaining a high-quality vineyard.
